### RESUME WORKSHOP

This workshop will provide students with a step by step process on how to build an effective resume. With the help of our staff the students will craft a well rounded resume that can be used to apply for all job opportunities. ### APPLICATION WORKSHOP

### 2ND ROUND INTERVIEWS
